- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Ephesians 6:10-20 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.

This week's sermon is focused specifically on verse 15 and the shoes of the gospel of peace.

- 4) There are a couple key words in this verse, the first is the word "gospel." What is the gospel? As a group, take a minute to carefully define this word together.
- 5) The second word of importance in this verse is the word "peace." How does the gospel bring peace? What do we need peace from?
- 6) How has the gospel personally brought you peace?
- 7) Read Matthew 11:28-30 and Isaiah 52:7 together.
- 8) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 9) In what ways do the people around you most need peace? (neighbors, co-workers, family, etc.)
- 10) How can we be better known as peacemakers? What needs to change? What do we need to do? What do we need to believe? etc.
- 11) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
