- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Ephesians 6:10-20 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.

This week's sermon is focused specifically on verses 17-20 and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. The sermon also focuses prayer.

- 4) The only offensive weapon that Paul mentions is the Sword of the Spirit (the Word of God). How well would you say you can wield this sword? What would help you to wield it more effectively?
- 5) Read Matthew 4:1-11 about Jesus' temptation. What did you notice? What stuck out to you?
- 6) How has knowledge and understanding of the Word of God protected you in your life?
- 7) In verse 18, Paul instructs us to "pray at all times in the Spirit." What is he talking about? What does it mean to pray in the
- 8) Paul gives the Ephesians several things to pray for in verse 18-20. What are these different prayers? Do you pray for these things that Paul commands them to pray for? How might your prayer life need to change?
- 9) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
