- 1) Begin your time by briefly praying and asking the Holy Spirit to help you as you discuss and study.
- 2) Read Proverbs 27:17, James 4:11, & James 5:9.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 4) How do you think this "iron sharpening iron" thing works? Have you ever been in a relationship with friends who were helping you to love and follow Jesus better? Explain.
- 5) Are you in an iron-sharpening-iron relationship right now? Why or why not?
- 6) In the two James passages above, James encourages believers to not speak evil against one another. How are you doing in regard to this command?
- 7) Read 1 Thessalonians 5:11.
- 8) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 9) Who do you encourage? Who encourages you?
- 10) Read James 5:16, and Psalm 32:3-5.
- 11) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 12) Why do we need to confess our sins to one another?

- 13) If believers in Jesus are already forgiven for everything they've ever done, or ever will do (no condemnation - Romans 8:1), why does the Bible teach us to continue confessing our sin to God and asking Him for forgiveness?
- 14) Is there anything God is leading you to confess privately or publicly and ask forgiveness for?
- 15) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
