- 2) Read John 1:1-18 together.
- 3) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 4) We're focusing specifically on verse 14 in this passage, and in that verse, Jesus is referred to as "the Word." What is the significance of Jesus being called the word?
- 5) Why was it necessary for Jesus to become "flesh"?
- 6) What do you think it means to be full of grace and truth?
- 7) Describe someone who is full of truth, but lacks grace. Describe someone who is full of grace, but lacks truth. What is the problem with both of these? Which of these two errors are you more likely to fall into?
- 8) Read Philippians 2:6-11 together.
- 9) What stuck out to you as you read? Was there anything that you didn't understand? Discuss.
- 10) Why do you think it is so hard to put others before ourselves? What would help you to be more like Jesus?
- 11) End your time in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to help apply to your life what you've been learning and discussing.
